Devised performance. Development, rehearsal and performance of a play created as part of a group.

Practical exploration of set texts. Producing concepts based on the roles of actors, designers and directors. Exam preparations.

Written portfolio. Analysis and evaluation of the process and performance outcomes. Initial exploration of set texts.
